BULLETIN COURSE DESCRIPTION

Academic service learning practicum/internship experience as an undergraduate instructional aide. Participation in the teaching of a regular instructionally-related class. (Students may earn a maximum of 4 units toward the baccalaureate degree for any course(s) numbered 685 regardless of discipline.)

PREREOUISITES

- Upper division standing and consent of the instructor. AAS 685 cannot be taken for graduate level units or credit.
- 3.3 grade point average (GPA) in Asian American Studies and AAS-related courses.
- Student cannot concurrently be enrolled in the class for which he/she is serving as Instructional Aide (IA).
- Preference will be given to students who have previously taken the class for which he/she is serving as IA.

MINIMUM COURSE REQUIREMENTS (additional requirements subject to the instructor)

- Regular attendance and participation in every class session.
- Serve as role model and mentor to students in class.
- Responsible, timely, and proactive assistance to instructor.
- MIDTERM 4-6 page paper on what was learned to date from the IA experience and areas of improvement for the class.
- FINAL 4-6 page paper on what was learned for the entire semester from the IA experience, which may include:
 - o The teaching of Asian American Studies.
 - Working with undergraduate students.
 - o Course content/material.
 - o Student's relationship to the Asian American community.
 - o Student's understanding of theories/analysis/application of the course.
 - o Student's own personal growth, identity development, and lifelong learning.
 - Student's understanding and value for social justice, diversity, and internationalization of the Asian American community.
- IMPORTANT NOTE: IAs cannot grade or be involved with any activity/information that might violate the privacy/confidentiality of the students enrolled in the class.
